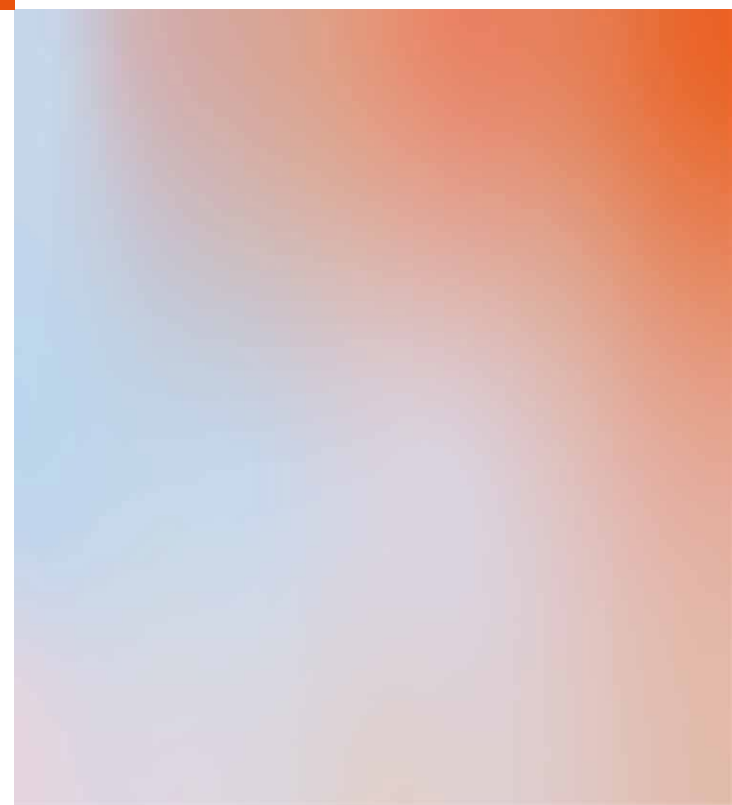
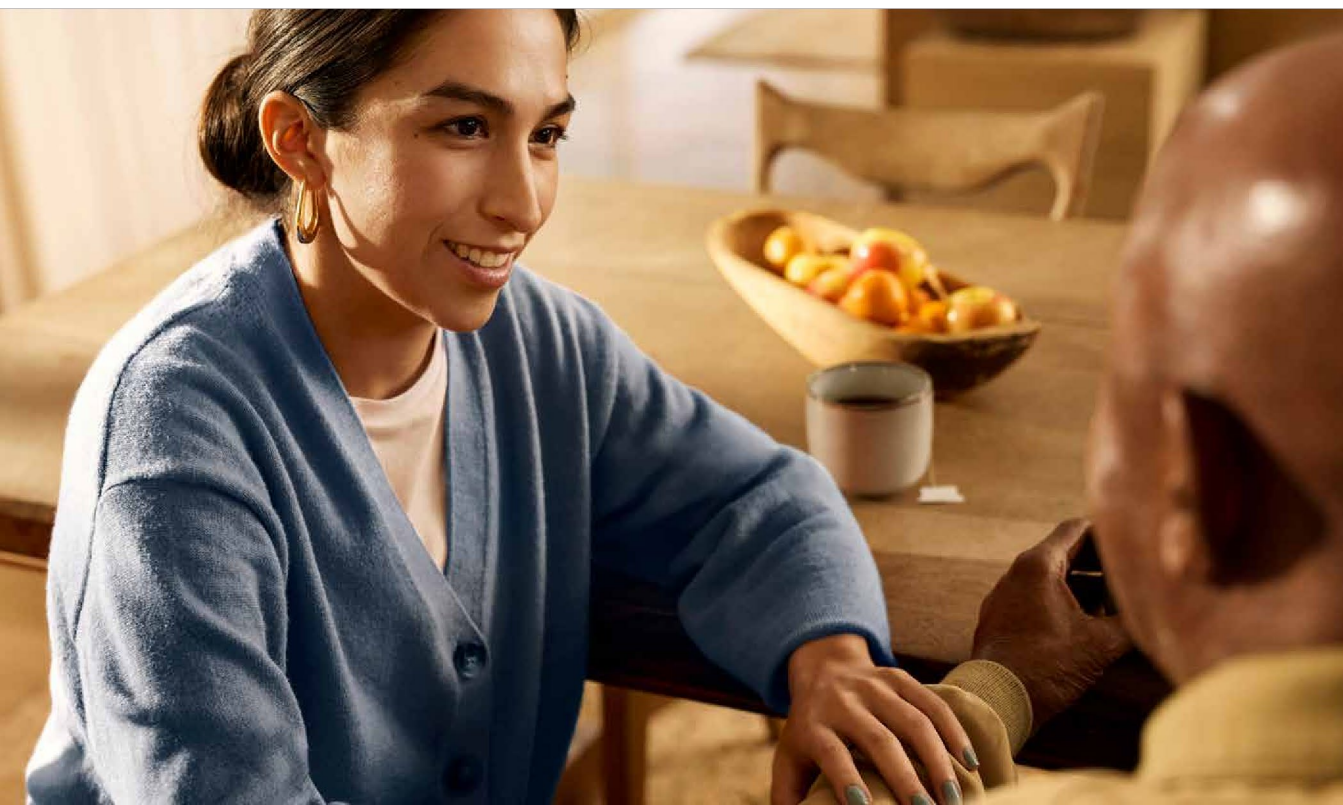


# Patient Organization Funding Report 2025



## Description of funding category

**Grants** are freely given to support medical/scientific research, education and patient advocacy activities with no consequent obligation on the recipient to provide benefits in return.

**Membership fee** (annual, monthly) of a patient organization which purpose aligns with Novartis mission to discover new ways to improve and extend people's lives.

Funding of **research collaborations and consortium activities** undertaken by Novartis with patient organizations to advance specific and shared objectives.

**Donations** are freely given for the purpose of enhancing healthcare, or supporting communities that Novartis associates have a presence in with no consequent obligation on the recipient to provide benefits in return. Donations can include monetary funding and used items such as equipment or furniture.

**Speaker engagements** can include patient journey, testimonials, interviews, speaking at events. **Consultancy activities** can include participation in advisory boards, patient councils and focus groups. **Services** can include conducting surveys, run qualitative interviews.

**Services provided to a patient organization by a third-party** such as meeting organization, printing of material, translation services, digital capacity building, conducting a virtual webinar, developing or maintaining website, etc.

**Sponsorship** can include funding provided to a patient organization to run an advisory board, to support fundraising events organized by a patient advocacy organization, to support corporate citizenship activities in communities where Novartis has a presence or participation in a corporate membership program led by a patient advocacy organization.

**Non-monetary support** provided by Novartis without third-party intermediary. Support given can include Novartis employee manpower, use of Novartis meeting rooms or facilities, provision of expertise or services from a Novartis associate.
