We seek to adhere to all privacy laws and enforce clear [policies on protecting personal information \(PDF 0.1 MB\)](#) ^[2], including genetic data. Our data privacy program includes a global organization and infrastructure as well as procedures and trainings to support local activities and help our efforts to ensure compliance. In addition, [The Novartis Binding Corporate Rules](#) ^[3] are a system of principles, rules and tools designed to ensure effective levels of data protection, in particular relating to transfers of personal information outside Europe and Switzerland.
