COVID-19

Symptoms include fever, cough, tiredness, headache, sore throat and shortness of breath<sup>2</sup>



8 out of 10 people who catch the virus have mild illness and recover without needing medical assistance<sup>3</sup>



A few people may develop pneumonia, making it difficult to breath and this can be fatal<sup>2</sup>
